Class is limited to 20 students: Preferred minimum 3 years fire experience, however less will be accepted based on overall class enrollment. Indication of years of experience below required.

Course Description: The RIT Concepts course provides students with the solid foundation and skills needed to perform as a member of a rapid intervention team on the fireground. It is designed to expose as well as prepare firefighters for the complexities of utilizing RIT operations both physically and mentally that can be experienced during a Mayday rescue of one of our own. This physically demanding class uses extensive hands-on evolutions developing core skill sets to apply in vigorous scenario based environments in an acquired structure.

Skill Sets covered: FF Survival, FF self-rescue, RIT command operations, emergency air supply, assessing and packaging a firefighter, drags and carries, rescues from entanglements, wall breaching, SCBA knowledge

Required Equipment:

Full structural firefighting PPE

One SCBA per person with one extra tank (2 if possible)

One RIT air supply bag per department if applicable

One 150-300ft rope bag per department

This is free class. Each student will be registered in SMOKE by the Genesee County Training Committee Chairman since this a closed course being offered only to GCAFC member departments personnel.
